



## CSFC Accomplishments 2021

CSFC remains active during challenging times, continuing to meet monthly to keep our members informed about the latest issues affecting county offices of education and their facilities.

Our organization's accomplishments in 2021 include:

- Represented COEs during bond bill negotiations and facilities funding advocacy, to ensure equitable inclusion of COEs and consideration of their unique facilities needs [AB 75 (O'Donnell) and SB 22 (Glazer)].
  - Focused advocacy on maintaining and expanding Financial Hardship provisions.
- Presented a workshop at the CASH Annual Conference in June 2021: *Modernizing School Safety Plans to Meet Today's Challenges*.
- Presented a workshop at the CASH Fall Conference in October 2021: *Indoor Air Quality in Classrooms: cleanclassroomair.com*.
- Hosted a successful virtual CSFC Annual Summit in September 2021.
- Supported AB 599 (Jones-Sawyer), which updated the criteria for developing the list of schools for *Williams* inspections. The bill was signed into law in 2021.
- Worked with CalRecycle to provide COE feedback on implementation of the SB 1383 organic waste recycling requirements and provide information to our members.
- Provided an ongoing forum to discuss challenges and share solutions on issues including:
  - Safely operating schools during the COVID-19 pandemic;
  - Creating outdoor learning environments;
  - Use of Federal COVID-19 relief funds for school facilities;
  - Facility Inspection Tool revisions;
  - AB 130 Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten, and Full-Day Kindergarten Facilities Grant Program development and funding opportunities.
