About the CSFC Executive Committee

As CSFC's governing body, the Executive Committee is tasked with developing and approving the organization's goals and priorities, providing guidance for the organization regarding advocacy on policy issues, and handling the administration of the organization. Executive Committee members participate in regular CSFC meetings, typically held the fourth Wednesday of each month, and the CSFC Annual Summit in the Fall. Executive Committee members play an important role in shaping these events and providing leadership to their COE colleagues, while serving as a network of support to each other.

Executive Committee Qualifications and Terms

Executive Committee members serve two-year terms with the opportunity to be re-elected to additional terms. CSFC shall endeavor to balance the membership of the Executive Committee with representation of large, medium, and small-sized county offices as well as geographical distribution from southern, central, and northern California.

Nominees must be employed by a current CSFC county office of education member.
