PUBLIC OUTREACH & EDUCATION

Goal: "measurably increase the knowledge of the target communities...and...measurably change the behavior of the target audiences"

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT & PARTICIPATION

- "shall involve the public in the planning and implementation of activities..."
- "Volunteerism, public comment, input and activism shall be encouraged

Minimum requirements:

- Involve public in establishing program goals
- Establish a citizen's advisory group
- Create sponsorship opportunities
- Ensure ease of public finding your info
- Reporting

ILLICIT DISCHARGE DETECTION & ELIMINATION



- Storm drain system GIS map
 - locations of outfalls and drainage areas
 - Location & names of all water bodies receiving discharges
 - ID Priority areas
 - Field Screening stations

POLLUTION PREVENTION





- Inventory of all owned and operated facilities
 - Chemical storage/composting
 - Equipment storage (M&O)
 - Fuel Islands (Transportation)
 - Hazardous waste handling (garage, pool house)
 - Materials storage yards (grounds)
 - Schools
 - Parking lots, swimming polls, parks
 - Vehicle yards

POLLUTION PREVENTION



- Map of all of the above
- Assessments (Hot Spots)
- Pollution prevention plans
- Inspection & monitoring (Min 1X yr)
- Maintenance of storm drains (1-3X/Yr)
- M&O Activities
- Reporting, reporting, reporting
